CEM'IN'EU CHOOSES FIVES FCB FOR THE PROVISION ITS NEW GRINDING STATION WITH A CAPACITY OF 250 000 TONNES

Paris, June 2019 - Cem'In'Eu, a new player in the cement production sector in France, has selected Fives FCB, a leader in industrial cement engineering and mineral grinding, to equip its future production site in Portes les Valence (Drôme).

This project is a new phase in Cem'In'Eu's business plan, following the opening of its first site Aliénor in Tonneins (Lot-et-Garonne) in 2018. The Portes les Valence plant will provide Cem'In'Eu with an additional capacity of around 250,000 tonnes of cement per year from the second half of 2020, for an investment in the region of \notin 24 million.

This grinding station will offer the best performance in terms of reliability. It will mainly consist of raw materials loading, clinker, limestone and gypsum hoppers, a 34 t/h CEM II A/L FCB B-mill (ball mill) operating in a closed circuit with a high efficiency FCB TSV[™] dynamic classifier.

Fives FCB's experience in the construction of cement grinding station is based on over 300 FCB B-mills and more than 250 FCB TSV[™] dynamic classifiers installed worldwide.

"This contract forms the basis of a true partnership between Cem'In'Eu and Fives FCB, which will involve the supply of other production units in France and Europe," said Vincent Lefebvre, Chairman and Founding Partner of Cem'In'Eu.

"By choosing the international engineering group Fives as a partner, Cem'In'Eu, a rapidly expanding player in the sector, recognises Fives' ability to develop sustainable and efficient technologies and to be a true industrial partner for its customers," said Alain Cordonnier, CEO of Fives FCB.
